

H1N1 Antiviral Return Form

During the 2009 H1N1 influenza public health emergency your facility accepted antiviral medications from the Strategic National Stockpile Program. During the 2009 H1N1 influenza public health emergency the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued emergency use authorizations (EUAs) that authorized certain unapproved uses of antiviral drugs (Tamiflu, Relenza, Peramivir), N95 respirators and diagnostics kits.

As of June 23, 2010, the EUAs authorizing the unapproved uses of these products is no longer in effect. Therefore the Strategic National Stockpile Program is asking that you return all of the antiviral drugs and personal protective equipment (PPE) provided to you by the Program that has not been dispensed. This material will be maintained for use in the event of a future pandemic
