- Most nursing home rooms would **NOT** be considered patient care rooms, so they would **NOT** need medical grade power strips.
- ➤ Patient care room any room of a health care facility wherein patients are intended to be examined or treated.
- ➤ Patient care related electrical equipment electrical equipment that is intended to be used for diagnostic, therapeutic, or monitoring purposes.

NON-PATIENT CARE ROOM POWER STRIP REQUIRMENTS:

Any UL listed power strip may be used however, high amperage devices should never be attached (microwaves, refrigerators or space heaters).

PATIENT CARE ROOM POWER STRIP REQUIREMENTS:

- ➤ Power strips providing power to <u>patient care related</u> electrical equipment must be Special-purpose Relocatable Power Taps (SPRPT) listed as UL 1363A or UL 60601-1
- ➤ Power strips providing power to <u>non-patient-care-related</u> electrical equipment must be Relocatable Power Taps (RPT) listed as UL 1363.
